

## Guidelines for abstract submission

The website should be used to submit a Word Document (Margins 2cm and font Times Roman 12) containing:

- (i) **Lay Abstract**, a **short** paragraph (150 words, plain text, no figures) explaining the research and its significance in non-technical language.
- (ii) **Scientific Abstract**, a complete scientific description of the research (300 words, plain text, no figures including headings, authors and authors affiliations) including its significance to health and medicine.

### **ABSTRACT TITLE, AUTHORS' NAMES AND AFFILIATIONS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING FORMAT:**

**Title:** in **CAPITALS, BOLD, CENTER ALIGNMENT**

**Authors:** include First name (initials) and Surname of all authors and underline the presenting author.

**Authors' affiliations:** in *Italics*. List the authors' affiliations referring to authors with *super script numbers*.

**Body text:** Sentence case.

The Word document should be labelled as follows

"[LAST NAME]\_[INITIALS]\_PG.doc" for the Post-graduate

**Do not include brackets or spaces in the file name but do include the underscore. eg. JONES\_JE\_PG.doc**

**Applications exceeding character/page limitations or in the incorrect format may be rejected.**
