### The ASMR Queensland Health & Medical Research Awards are proudly supported by the Queensland Government

These prestigious Awards recognise excellence in all areas of health-related research performed in Queensland.

#### 1. Postgraduate Student Researcher Award.

Eligibility: enrolled students or recent graduates no more than one year since degree conferral.

Prize - winner \$1000

#### 2. Early-Career Researcher Award.

Eligibility: more than twelve months but no more than five years (inclusive) of completing their higher degree.

Prize - winner \$2000

#### 3. Mid-Career Researcher Award.

Eligibility: more than five years but no more than twelve years (inclusive) of completing a higher degree.

Prize - winner \$3000

#### 4. Clinical Researcher Award.

Eligibility: a clinician or allied health professional within ten years (inclusive) of completing their highest degree/specialist qualification.

Prize - winner \$3000
