Professor Dun was already researching childhood cancers when his career took a deeply personal turn. In 2018, his two-year-old daughter Josephine was diagnosed with an incurable form of paediatric cancer, Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG).

In the wake of Josephine's diagnosis and death, Professor Dun has used his personal and professional experience to create new hope for those diagnosed with DIPG through advocacy and research.

Professor Dun's National Press Club address will inspire with stories of hope, updates on progress being made in DIPG research and emerging treatments for paediatric brain cancer. He will also share his perspective on how government and philanthropists should partner to address community priorities for medical research.
