ASMR Medical Research Week® Program FEATURING THE "ELECTRIFYING" BARONESS SUSAN GREENFIELD, ASMR MEDALLIST 2010

Baroness Susan Greenfield CBE is Professor of Pharmacology at the University of Oxford, where she leads a multi-disciplinary team investigating neurodegenerative disorders. In addition she is Director of the Oxford Centre for the Science of the Mind, exploring the physical basis of consciousness and was the Director of the Royal Institution of Great Britain 1998 - 2010 (the first woman to hold that position). Baroness Greenfield is also Director of the Institute for the Future of the Mind, part of the James Martin 21st Century School, which exploits the parallels between the brains of the very young and very old, and how they are all vulnerable to technology, chemical manipulation, and disease. Tim Radford, Science Editor of The Guardian has described her as being 'like electricity, shocking but also illuminating.'
