The School of Molecular and Biomedical Sciences at Adelaide University invites individuals to participate in an experiment to determine "How long does it take to metabolise a Mars Bar?" using an exercise bike and calorie counter.

Kirsty Pringle, ASMR EXPO convenor, is very excited about this year's event and says "Scientists are often thought of as crazy people wearing white lab coats and frazzled hair that stare down a microscope all day.
